



AFF Cycling Agreement Contract

I hereby acknowledge and agree to the following Arkansas Freedom Fund (AFF) program agreement terms and conditions:

Section 1

1. *_____(Initial) Bicycles are issue out clean and in proper working condition and must be returned in the same manner.
2. *_____(Initial) Helmets are not included but are always requires to be worn while riding bicycles issued from the AFF.
3. *_____(Initial) The AFF DOES NOT MAINTAIN YOUR BIKE, YOU DO!!! [AFF Program Bikes must be cleaned, serviced, and stored indoors at the issued rider's expense]. AFF Program Bikes are the property of the AFF. If at any time I decide that I desire NOT to ride the bike regularly, I will return it to the AFF.
4. *_____(Initial) AFF cycling program members agree to return the bike in clean, UNDAMAGED condition to avoid any ADDITIONAL charges for repair, maintenance or replacement. I accept use of the equipment, AS IS, in good condition and accepts full responsibility for care of the equipment while under his/her possession. Damaged parts or components will be repaired/replaced at the AFF Program discretion and I agree to pay regular shop rates and retail prices for components replaced. Clean condition means normal wear and tear is accepted but does not include broken spokes, rims, bent rims, damaged frames, handlebars, seats or other parts from misuse and/or crashes.
5. *_____(Initial) All bikes should be returned clean of mud and debris. Any bike not returned clean will be assessed a 1-hour shop fee of \$50 additional. When a bike is returned you must coordinate the drop-off and inspection details with an AFF cycling program manager.

Section 2

When you are ready to return your AFF program bike, you need to do the following things:

1. *_____(Initial) Clean your bike and all its parts. Your bike must be free of any defects, damage and or missing parts. You must return all parts in their original configuration or have proof of upgrades, modifications, and or changes being done by AFF recognized cycling professionals.



2 * _____(Initial) I will not get reimbursed for any modifications or changes to upgrade my bike or restore it to its original or issued configuration.

3. * _____(Initial) I understand, AFF program bikes can **ONLY be issued by or returned to AFF cycling program managers.** Cycling Program managers will ensure all bikes being issued or returned meet required safety and service requirements to be reissued. NOTE: BIKES BEING TURNED IN SHOULD BE ABLE TO BE REISSUED IMMEDIATELY. If a bike needs to be serviced upon turn-in, **I UNDERSTAND I MUST PAY TO HAVE THE BIKE SERVICED by an AFF affiliate bike shop.**

4. * _____(Initial) If the bike is lost or stolen, I will pay the Manufactures Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) for the bike. If I fail to return a program bike within 30 days' notice, I will pay the MSRP of the bike, accessories, and all AFF property listed in the AFF cycling agreement.

1. * _____(Initial) Initials of individual over 18 years of age or parent/legal guardian of minor under 18 years of age or legal guardian of incapacitated and/or intellectually disabled person.
